PROJECT OBJECTIVES

Promote sustainable exploitation of the natural resources of the cross border region constanta - dobrich.

CURRENT REALITY

- Dobrich Constanta cross border region has one of the richest natural diversity in Europe
- The region is a magnet for international and domestic visitors because of its long beaches and attractive coastline
- Culture and History- evidence for the oldest settlements
- Strong increase of anthropogenic pressure on the marine and coastal areas as a result of development of tourism infrastructure in the last couple of years.
- Irresponsible exploitation of the natural resources: hotels with uncontrolled disposal of waste and wastewater, over-consumption of resources (electricity, drinking water and use of energy intensive consumables)
- As a result negative image and reputation of the region as underdeveloped and with low awareness of the environmental management and protection

CHALLENGES AND BLOCKERS

- Lack of information on the rate of the damage to the environment from the tourism business in the cross border region.
- Lack of information on models of environment friendly behaviour in the businesses, eco-innovative technologies and equipment.
- No professionals and experts in cross-border region to consult


the tourism business about EMAS and the European Eco label.
