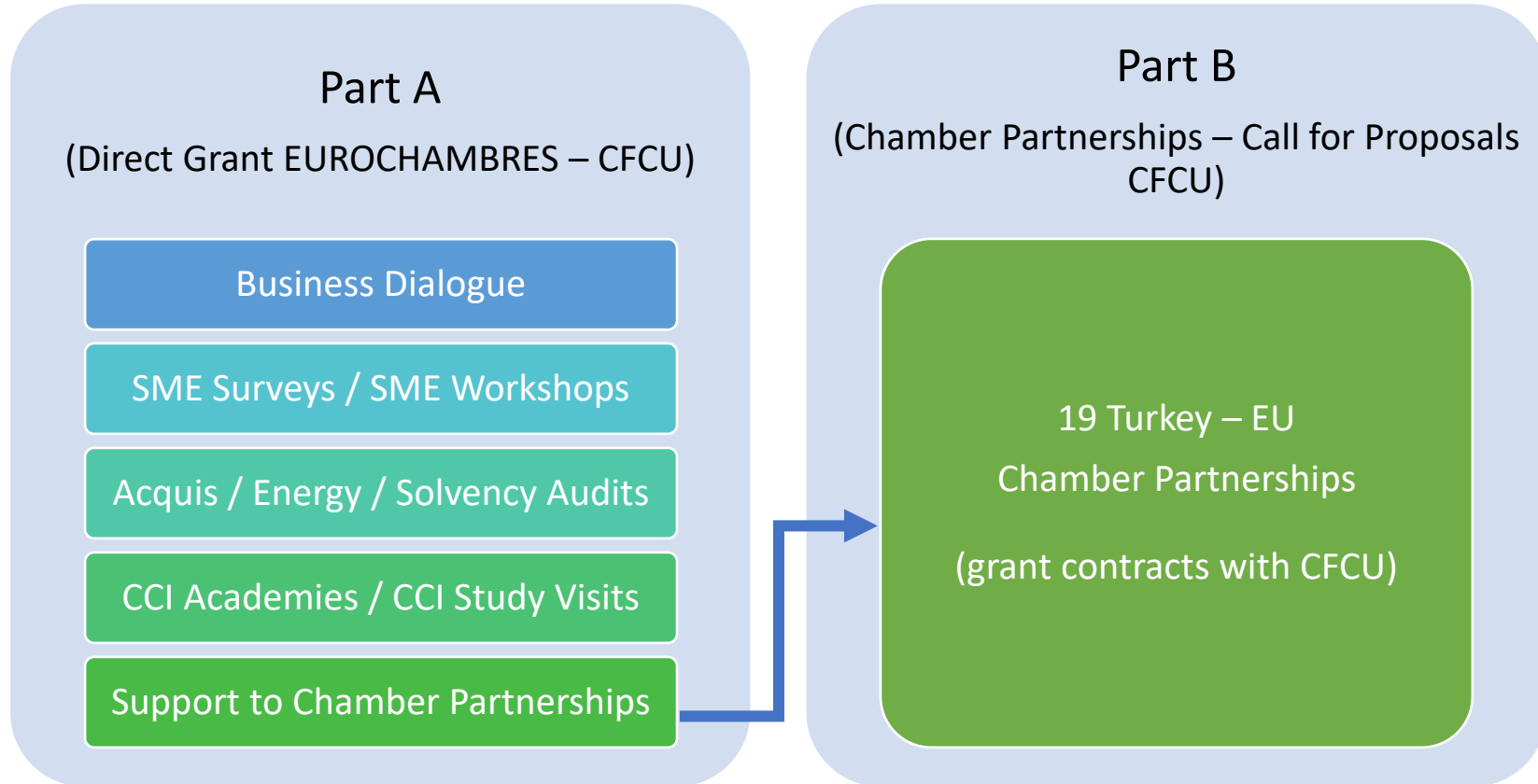

SME Surveys in Türkiye

- ❑ **The 2021 survey results show a strong support among Turkish companies for the EU process.**
 - 60% support the EU accession process.
- ❑ **Information needs increased.**
 - Green Deal is changing the context of Customs Union relationship.
- ❑ **TEBD's responsibility has increased.**
 - Although TEBD Project launched in July 2018, almost one-third of the Turkish companies has heard of TEBD.

SME Surveys in Türkiye



- ❑ **Customs Union has transformed Türkiye**
 - From an agrarian country to an industrial country
- ❑ **There is strong support among Turkish companies for the EU process**
 - Customs Union rather than the EU accession process
 - Turkish companies are closely following the EU's green and digital transformation process
 - Information needs diversified with the Green Deal
 - The role of TEBD as a new instrument is gaining traction
- ❑ **De-carbonization is an opportunity for EU-TR relations**
 - Modernization of the Customs Union turns into a transformative agenda with the Green Deal
 - Immigration too transactional
 - De-carbonization is not only about climate
 - From energy policy to trade policy, from security policy to industrial policy



SME Surveys in the EU



- ❑ **The third edition of the EU-Turkey Business Dialogue SME Surveys on EU and Turkish business perspectives on EU-Türkiye economic relations**
 - Earlier surveys were conducted in 2008 and 2013
- ❑ **EU companies have a positive view of Türkiye**
 - 46% of the EU firms believe Türkiye's EU membership will have a positive effect on their businesses
 - EU firms, which are not familiar with the Turkish market but would like to develop business relations increased from 31% to 53% between 2013 and 2022
- ❑ **TEBD's responsibility has increased**
 - EU enterprises are seeking to be better informed about the Customs Union
 - EU firms are supportive of modernization of the Customs Union
 - EU businesses support collaboration regarding the Green Deal and Digital Single Market between the EU and Türkiye



SME Surveys in the EU



- ❑ **EU businesses express a high level of interest in the Turkish market and support Customs Union modernization**
 - EU firms, which are not familiar with the Turkish market but would like to develop business relations increased from 31% to 53% between 2013 and 2022
 - 46% of the EU firms believe Türkiye's EU membership will have a positive effect on their businesses
- ❑ **Customs Union modernization is all about de-carbonization and digitalization in Türkiye**
 - Almost half of EU companies express a lack of knowledge on the modernization of the Customs Union
 - 77% and 57% of the EU companies support collaboration between EU and Türkiye regarding the Green Deal and Digital Single Market respectively
- ❑ **TEBD's responsibility has increased**
 - Awareness raising on the meaning Customs Union modernization
 - 34% of the EU firms needs information on Customs Union (34%), needs information on finding business partners (34%), funding opportunities (19%)

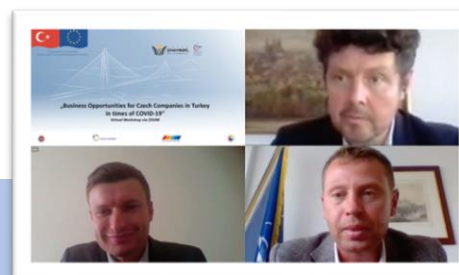

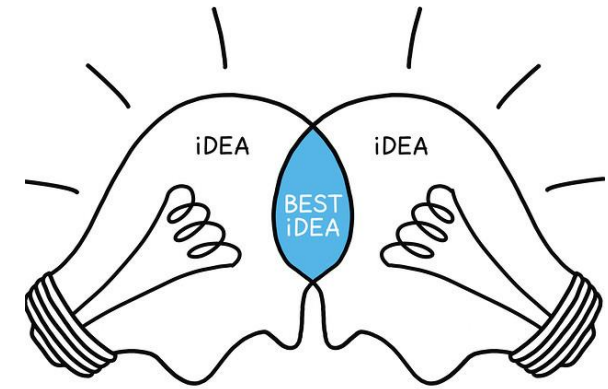

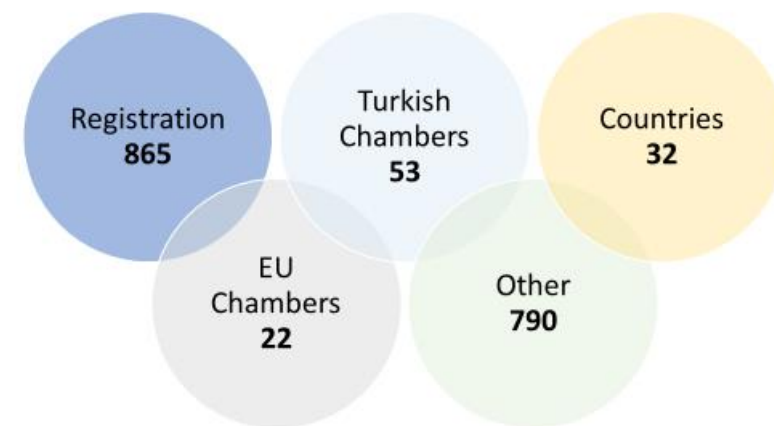
