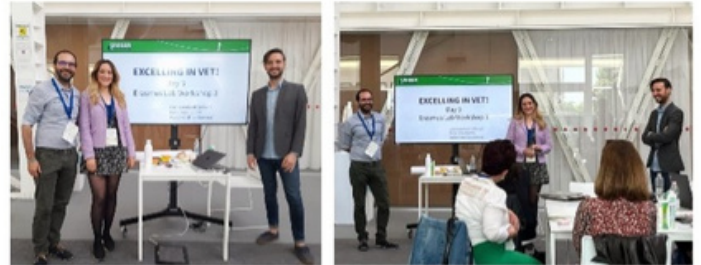


## MOSAIC at UNISER Teacher Week!

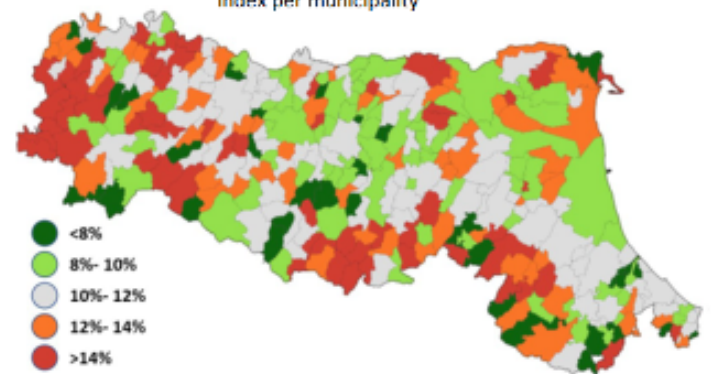
## Emilia-Romagna (Italy): Generation-turnover in Craft companies
